HOW CAN YOU USE THE PRAYER CALENDAR?

Daily, use the Bible passages each day for a devotional time. Read each passage and meditate and think about that text. Ask God to give you wisdom to apply this passage to your life. It would be good to jot down your thoughts on a note pad. Pray with each verse, for you or for another person. First of all, concentrate on honoring the name of the Lord in your life, your church, your community, and our state. Pray for the people who are close to you. Pray for our community (their leaders, influential people who can make a difference). Make plans to use this calendar as a time for family prayer, reading the Bible passages, sharing about what the Bible says and praying together.
